<b>Item No. 27  July 12, 2018  ss</b>	By the order passed in the context with the order dated 10 <sup>th</sup> July, 2018 in the case of Legal Aid, National Green Tribunal Bar Association Vs. NCT of Delhi & Ors in Original Application No. 108 of 2013, we restrained the groundwater extraction for the purpose of industries/commercial activity by the organizations engaged in packaging/sale of water or aerated beverages or commercial supply of ground water in violation of the rules, having regard to the status of the availability of the ground water. Applying the said order to the present case, we direct that the industries which do not have any permission/authorization from the competent authority
