

Subject: Compassionate appointments - internal instructions - regarding

The undersigned is directed to refer to DoPT's Instructions regarding appointment on compassionate grounds issued vide their O.M. No. 14014/6/94-Estt. (D) dated 9.10.98, as amended from time to time. These instructions, inter-alia, lay down setting up of a Committee in each Ministry/Department/Organisation, who are to consider cases of compassionate appointments and make suitable recommendations. It has been seen that the Committees set up in this Ministry and its organisations adopt different procedures for deciding about the penurious conditions of the family of the deceased Government Servant before they make recommendations regarding appointment or otherwise on compassionate grounds.

2. In order to bring about a uniform procedure and comprehensive guidelines (as has been adopted by some other Ministries/Departments), it has now been decided to lay down relative merit points based on various aspects such as family pension, terminal benefits and number of dependents, etc, to assess the suitability of all applicants, so that only the most deserving cases are recommended by the Screening Committee for compassionate appointments. The 100- point scale, based on various attributes indicated in the scheme for compassionate appointment for a comparatively balanced and objective assessment of the requests of really deserving candidates is indicated below:

(a) Family Pension (Basic excluding DA & Allowances)




The undersigned is directed to refer to the Ministry's O.M. of even No. dated 29.1.2005 on the subject mentioned above wherein internal guidelines on a 100-point scale, based on various aspects indicated in the scheme for compassionate appointment, was circulated, for a comparatively balanced and objective assessment of the applications for compassionate appointment. Due to the implementation of the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations, it was felt necessary to review some of the parameters in the internal guidelines relating to family pension, terminal benefits and monthly income. Based on the recommendations of the Screening Committee the merit points pertaining to family pension, terminal benefits and monthly income have been revised as mentioned in the following tabulations:
