2. On grant of financial upgradation under Scheme, there shall be no change in the designation, classification or higher status. The financial upgradation shall be purely personal to the employee and shall have no relevance to his/her seniority position. However, financial and certain other benefits, which are linked to the pay drawn by the Officers, shall be permitted.
3. With regard to fixation of pay on grant of financial upgradation under the MACPS, the officer has an option under FR 22(1)(a)(1) to get his pay fixed in the higher grade pay either from the date his financial upgradation or from the date of his next increment.
4. Grant of higher pay scale under the MACPS shall be conditional to the fact that when financial upgradation has been allowed and the officer subsequently refuses the promotion, it shall not be a ground to withdraw the financial upgradation.
5. On making fixation of pay, the officer concerned is advised to submit an undertaking to the effect that arrears of pay on account of granting financial upgradation under the MACPS will be subject to any audit objection etc. and he will refund the amount drawn by him as excess pay and allowances by virtue of higher pay scale in lump sum, in case it is found that the same is not applicable in his/her case.
6. While issuing pay fixation orders, a Para may be added to the effect that the above fixation of pay in the upgraded scale is subject to review by audit. Any over payment on account of pay fixation in the upgraded scale as pointed out by the audit will be recovered from him in lump-sum.
7. The financial upgradation under the MACP Scheme shall be purely personal to the officers and shall have no relevance to his seniority position. As such, there shall be no additional financial upgradation for the senior officers on the ground that the junior officer in the grade has got higher scale under the MACP Scheme.
