**G.S.R. 381.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Water Resources, Central Ground Water Board, Executive Engineer, Group 'A' Post Recruitment Rules, 2011, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Executive Engineer in the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Central Ground Water Board, namely:-

**1. Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Water Resources, Central Ground Water Board, Executive Engineer, Group 'A' Post Recruitment Rules, 2017.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix.**—The number of said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

**3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.**—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

**4. Disqualification.**—No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**5. Power to relax.**—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**6. Saving.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

**Promotion:**

Assistant Executive Engineer in Level-10 (Rs.56,100) in the pay matrix with five years regular service in the grade and possessing a Diploma in Civil or Mechanical or Agricultural or Mining or Electrical or Drilling Engineering or in Petroleum Technology from a recognised Institute or University.

Two weeks training from Rajiv Gandhi National Ground Water Training and Research Institute, Raipur or in any other National Level Institute on following topics:-

- (i) Management principles and practices;
- (ii) Administrative and Finance.

**Note :** Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors shall also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

**Deputation:**

Officer of the Central Government or State Government or Union territories Administration,-

- (a) (i) holding analogous post on a regular basis in the parent cadre or Department; or
- (ii) with five years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in Level-10 (Rs.56,100) in the pay matrix in the parent cadre or Department; and
- (b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:

**Essential:**

- (i) Degree in Civil or Mechanical or Agricultural or Mining or Electrical or Drilling Engineering or Degree in Petroleum Technology from a recognised University or Institute; and
- (ii) Five years experience in the use of Mechanical Drilling Rigs.

**Desirable:**

Two years experience of tube wells and allied ground water investigations.

**Note 1:** The Departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by deputation and similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

**Note 2:** Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed four years.

**Note 3:** The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
