G.S.R. 55.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Central Ground Water Board (Scientific Group 'A' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1995, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Central Ground Water Board (Scientific Group 'A' Posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1997.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Central Ground Water Board (Scientific Group 'A' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1995 hereinafter referred as the said rules, in rule for sub-rule (3) the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely :—

"(3) (a) The total number of posts in the grades of Scientists B (Junior Hydrogeologist), Scientist 'C' and Scientist 'D' put together in Hydrogeology discipline shall be 278. The senior most 16 officers in the grade of Scientist 'D' shall be functionally deployed as Superintending Hydrogeologist. The next 99 officers in grades of Scientist 'B' and Scientist 'C' shall be functionally deployed as Senior Hydrogeologist and the remaining officers shall be functionally deployed as Junior Hydrogeologist. The shortfall occurring in a year in the total strength of 278

officers in the Hydrogeologist discipline shall be the vacancies arising in that particular year in the grade of Scientist 'B' (Junior Hydrogeologist) provided the total strength of Scientist 'B' (Junior Hydrogeologist) does not exceed 163. This total number of 278 posts is subject to variation depending on workload.

(b) The total number of posts in the grades of Scientist 'B' (Junior Geophysicist), Scientist 'C' and Scientist 'D' put together in Geophysical discipline shall be 27. The senior most Scientist 'D' in the Geophysical discipline shall be functionally deployed as Superintending Geophysicist and the next 5 senior most officers in the grades of Scientist 'D' and Scientist 'C' shall be functionally deployed as Senior Geophysicist and the remaining officers shall be deployed as Junior Geophysicist. The shortfall occurring in a year in the total strength of 27 officers in the Geophysical discipline shall be the vacancies arising in that particular year in the grade of Scientist 'B' (Junior Geophysicist) provided the total strength of Scientist 'B' (Junior Geophysicist) does not exceed 21. This total number of 27 posts is subject to variation depending on workload.

(c) The total number of posts in the grades of Scientist 'B' (Hydrometeorologist), Scientist 'C' and Scientist 'D' put together in Hydrometeorology discipline shall be 7. All the 7 officers in the Hydrometeorology discipline shall be functionally deployed as Hydrometeorologist. The shortfall occurring in a year shall be the vacancies arising in that

particular year in the grade of Scientist 'B' (Hydrometeorologist). This total number of 7 posts is subject to variation depending on workload.

(d) The total number of posts in the grades of Scientist 'B' (Chemist), Scientist 'C' and Scientist 'D' put together in Chemical discipline shall be 23. The senior most Scientist 'D' in the Chemical discipline shall be functionally deployed as Superintending Chemist and the next 7 senior most officers in the grades of Scientist 'D' and Scientist 'C' in the Chemical discipline shall be functionally deployed as Senior Chemist and the remaining officers shall be functionally deployed as Chemist. The shortfall occurring in a year in the total strength of 23 officers in the Chemical discipline shall be the vacancies arising in that particular year in the grade of Scientist 'B' (Chemist) provided the total strength of Scientist 'B' (Chemist) does not exceed 15. This total number of 23 posts

is subject to variation depending on workload.

(e) The total number of posts in the grades of Scientist 'C' and Scientist 'D' put together in Hydrology discipline shall be 7. The senior most Scientist 'D' in the Hydrology discipline shall be functionally deployed as Superintending Hydrologist and remaining officers shall be functionally deployed as Senior Hydrologist. The shortfall occurring in a year in the total strength of 7 officers in the Hydrology discipline shall be the vacancies arising in that particular year in the grade or Scientist 'C' provided the total strength of Scientist 'C' does not exceed 6. This total number of 7 posts is subject to variation depending on workload".
