As the CGWB has been facing difficulties to get the suitable candidates in the past on the basis of the criteria of the present RR, two methods have been adopted for appointment through deputation/absorption as per DOPT table of residency period

Deputation/Re-employment: (For Armed Forces Personnel):

Armed Forces personnel of the rank of colonel or equivalent who are due to retire or are to be transferred to reserve within a period of one year and having the experience prescribed above, shall also be considered. If selected, such persons would be given deputation terms upto the date on which they are due for release from the Armed Forces and thereafter they may be continued on re-employment basis. In case such eligible officers have retired before the actual selection to the post is made, their appointment will be on re-employment basis. (Re-employment upto the age of superannuation with reference to Civil post)
