Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA) has been constituted in the erstwhile Ministry of Water Resources, (MoWR) under Section 3(3) of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 on the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to regulate and control ground water development and management in the country. The Authority is having All India jurisdiction. In exercise of powers conferred upon the Authority, CGWA performs various regulatory functions for regulation of ground water development in the country. With more areas coming under the purview of regulatory regime due to depleting ground water resources, the role of CGWA is becoming more and more important and requires adequate manpower and infrastructure to fulfill its mandate.
