Description	<p>Retired scientist(ICRISAT) Mr Murli Sharma has been using rainwater for all his water needs the past two decades. Mr Murli built himself a house in Hyderabad in 1995, and modelled to harvest rain water. Instead of an open courtyard, he built a tank below the house. The roof gives nearly 1.25 lakh litres rain water every year with the average rainfall. The house is designed in such a way that the rain water from the roof comes down by a PVC pipe and it passes through a filter and goes into a big underground tank, which has a capacity to hold over one lakh litre of water. Mr Murli and his family use the same water for drinking, cooking, their daily use and even maintain a small kitchen garden out front. He conducts workshops on a regular basis and is changing the landscape of his neighbourhood, where people are actively taking up his idea.</p>
